RBNZ BANK CAPITAL REVIEW

The Reserve Bank has published a consultation paper seeking feedback on proposals to almost double the required amount of high-quality capital that banks will have to hold. All members are urged to review this paper as the proposals could have large potential implications for the wider economy in terms of the cost and availability of credit.
